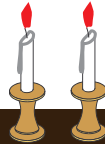

Halocha from the Daf

The Gemara relates that Ulla felt that any sounding of a noise is forbidden on Shabbos, even knocking on a door with one's fist. Rabbah held that the only sounding of noise which is forbidden is where the sounds create a song. This means it is forbidden to be forbidden, it must be a pleasant sound which is pleasing to hear. Rif and Rambam rule according to the lenient opinion of Rabbah. The only sounds which are disallowed are when they create a series of sounds which are discernible as a song. Making banging or knocking sounds are allowed. Rabeinu Chananel rules according to Ulla. He brings a proof to this ruling from a story in the Yerushalmi where Rebbe Ila'uh once came home late from the Bais Midrash and he found that his family was sleeping. He stayed outside and slept outside the door of his house, because he did not want to knock on the door on Shabbos. The Tur cites these two approaches in the halacha, and he notes that even according to the strict opinion of Rabeinu Chananel, it could be that the only time knocking alone is considered prohibited is when the person making the sound needs the noise which he makes, as we find by a person who knocks on a door to get other people's attention. However, if the noise is only incidental, even Ulla would agree that the noise does not have to be avoided.

Something for the Shabbos table

In this week's Parshas we read about how Bilam was hired to curse Bnei Yisrael and how Hashem made miracles [donkey talking, etc.] to prevent Bilam from cursing us. But, it's not so clear that we knew this was going on at the time; how were Bnei Yisrael supposed to know that a 'professional curser' was coming to curse them? In fact, there is at least one opinion that Bnei Yisrael did not find out about this until after the event. Here is a powerful message - sometimes Hashem saves us from our enemies without us even realising it! We say in tehillim 117 (and hallel) 'all the nations will praise Hashem for the kindness He has done to us (the Jews)'. Asks the Brisker Rav; why is it that specifically the non-Jews are praising Hashem for the kindness He shows to us? He answers that often the non-Jews had plotted against the Jews, and Hashem prevented these plans from coming to fruition. Therefore, the non-Jews were in the best position to recognise Hashem's kindness to us, but we - who didn't even know there was a plot, let alone that it was foiled - would not realise what was done to be able to thank HaShem for it. Such is the extent of HaShem's Chesed to us.
