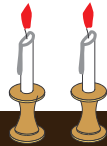

Halocha from the Daf

The Gemorah in Yoma 15 brings a concept that whenever one makes a turn it should always be to the right. One of the practical applications of this rule is in regards to the way we light the Chanukah lights. Most Rishonim apply the principal of turning towards the right as follows: on the first night of Chanukah one should place and light his candle in the holder furthest to the right. On the second night, one begins lighting with the new candle, which is on the left and turns to the right. According to other Rishonim the principle instructs us to begin on the right even though afterwards we will turn to the left. When it comes to the opening the Aron Hakodesh the Drisha writes that when one is honoured with taking out the Sefer Torah, he should push the curtain from left to right.

One may note an inconsistency between two minhagim. The minhag is to light Chanukah candles in accordance with the first opinion, starting on the left and turning to the right, and yet when opening the curtain many people push the curtain from the right to the left.

Some suggest that the practice of pushing the curtain from the right to the left is result of practical considerations. In order to ease the process of taking the Sefer Torah from the Aron Kodesh to be carried on the chazzan's right shoulder, the Sefer Torah is kept on the right side of the Aron Kodesh. Thus, it could be awkward to push the curtain to the right, open the door on the right and try to remove the Sefer Torah from the right side.

Something for the Shabbos table

At the beginning of the Parsha Yaakov asked Yosef to go to Shchem to check on 'Es Shalom Achecha V'Es Shalom Hatzon'; the welfare of his brothers and the welfare of the sheep.

The Kerem Shlomo says that the Roshei Teivos of these words (Aleph, Shin, Aleph, Vov, Shin, Hey) equals 613 for the Taryag Mitzvos. What is the connection?

He explains that it is impossible for any individual to fulfil all the mitzvos. Some of them are mutually exclusive. You can't be a Kohen and Yisroel at the same time, or a woman and a man, for example. So how can we have the zechus of all 613 mitzvos? Only through achdus (sticking together as one). If we make ourselves part of the Klal and treat each person as if they are a part of us (which according to Chazal they are) then their mitzvos are ours as well. That is why Yaakov told Yosef 'go check on the welfare of your brothers'. By doing that and caring about each and every Jew no matter how different they are than you or no matter how far estranged they are from you then you will have all taryag mitzvos - then you can fulfil the 613!!!
