Something for the Shabbos table

In this week's Parsha we are told about the mitzva of Shmittah; that there is to be a sabbatical year of rest. What's the idea of having one year in every seven of rest? One explanation given is that what one does in their 'time off' shows what they would really want to be doing all day. Therefore, Shmittah is supposed to be a year free from working land so that we can devote a year to learning Torah. And using the year to devote our time to Torah shows that if we did not have to work for 6 years then our ideal would be to learn Torah as much as possible. But sitting and wasting time in the seventh year shows that I am happy not to learn Torah for any of the 6 years, and I want my work to be a distraction to my obligation to learn Torah. In other words, what I do during the seventh year proves what I would really like to be doing in the other 6 years. And the same is true of Shabbos - our day off. Learning Torah on Shabbos has such an effect and reward because it proves that ideally I would want to learn as much in the week as possible too, just time constraints prevent me.
