### Thought for Elul

When a person hears Mussar and takes it to heart, deciding that he will change it is as if he already has changed.

It says in Avos D' Rav Nosson that a person whose Ma'asim / his deeds are more than his Chochma / wisdom, his Chochma will last. How can a person have more deeds than wisdom, asks Rabbeinu Yonah? If he does not know what to do, he cannot do it!

He answers that the moment a person makes up his mind to do whatever he will be told; it is as if he already did it even without knowing what it is that he must do. This was the secret of Na'aseh V'Nishma. Since they agreed to do anything Hashem asked, it is considered done before even knowing the task required.

We can now understand, says Rabbeinu Yonah, that if you damage any limb in the body, you pay for the limb. However if you damage a person's ability to hear, you pay his entire worth, since it has effected ones whole ability to improve.

## Something for the Shabbos table

Some of the Mitzvos in this week's parsha deal with things that should not be mixed / put together eg kilaim, shatnez, etc.

The Torah tells us not to wear shatnez (22;11) - this means wearing something which has a combination of wool and linen in.

What is the message of this law? The Midrash explains that this is based on the following; when the two sons of Adam; Kayin and Hevel argued and ultimately brought the first murder to the world, it was because one brought wool as part of their sacrifice to Hashem, and the other brought linen. Therefore, as a reminder not to cause machlokes, we are told never to mix these two materials - wool and linen; so that we live with this message. We see here the devastating effects of machlokes, and the extent that the Torah goes to try and rid us of any vestige of meaningless machlokes and breaking down of interpersonal relationships. After all, if Hashem is to be our Father, then we must agree to get on together as His children.
