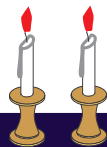

Halocha from the Daf

The Gemorah in Yevamos Daf 50 brings the opinion of Rav, who hold that if an inferior Chalitzah is performed, the Yevama must receive chalitzah from each of the brothers

The Terumas Hadeshen, was asked about a case of a minor who was mistakenly allowed to do Chalitzah because the Beis Din did not investigate her age. The specific question was whether it will be necessary for her to do Chalitzah with all the Yavamim since her first Chalitzah was invalid. On the one hand one could argue that an improper Chalitzah was done, similar to a case of one Yavam giving a Get to two Yevamos. In that case the Chalitzah is considered inferior, and according to Rav each Yevama requires a separate Chalitzah.

Accordingly, when Chalitzah is done to a minor it is considered deficient and when she becomes an adult she will be required to do Chalitzah with each Yavam. On the other hand, one could argue that Chalitzah done to a minor has no validity whatsoever and therefore it is considered as if it was not performed. Therefore, when she becomes an adult it will be sufficient to have one Chalitzah.

Something for the Shabbos table

At the beginning of this week's Parsha there is a very cryptic Ba'al Haturim. The Torah tells us about the dream of Yaakov Avinu; Yaakov sees a ladder which the angels are ascending & descending. The Ba'al Haturim comments that ladder ('sulam') has the same Gematria as money ('mamon') [28;12]. The reason, he says, is since money can be uplifted or bring someone down - as visibly demonstrated by the angels going up and down.

The question is, however, why is it that here specifically must this message regarding money be conveyed?

One answer given is that this was the point in Yaakov's life where he was changing from having all his needs taken care of by his parents at home, to going out into the world and needing to fend financially for himself. Therefore, he made a solid commitment to stand strong against the tests of money, as we see later on in his scrupulous observance of honesty in business in working for Lavan the crook. Consequently, it is upon his departure from his parents to the house of Lavan where we are given this vital message about money.
