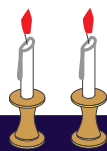

TAANIS OF THE BECHORIM

Who is considered a bechor in regard to Taanis Bechorim on Erev Pesach?

Concerning Taanis Bechorim, any first born male who is over thirty days old, whether first-born to his father or to his mother, is considered a bechor. A first-born of a kohen or a levi is considered like any other bechor in regard to Taanis Bechorim (See MB 470:2).

The status of a bechor born by cesarean section, or of a first-born non-Jew who converts, is a matter of disagreement among the poskim (Shevet ha-Levi 8:117). It is therefore recommended that these bechorim participate in a seudas mitzvah and thereby satisfy all opinions.

Something for the Shabbos table

At the beginning of this week's Parsha, Hashem tells Moshe to command Aharon and his sons about the Olah offering. Rashi notes that the word 'command' means doing things quickly (zerizus) and doing them right away after hearing the command.

Why is this so? The Kotzker Rav explains that there is a rule that one gets more reward for doing something that they were commanded to do than doing something that they were not commanded to do. This is because once one is commanded to do something, the yetzer hora naturally tries to pull one back and prevent the person from doing the mitzvah. Therefore, there is more of a struggle to fulfil and carry out something that they were commanded to do, and so more reward. He explains that this is why Rashi says here that 'command' entails zerizus, for once the command was passed to Aharon, he would naturally have a yetzer hora to hold back from doing the command, and so he had to go and fulfil the command speedily with zerizus, not giving the yetzer hora an opening.
