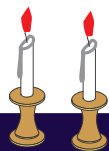

Thought for the Shabbos Table

Rabeinu Bachayei brings an important principle and novel understanding of the posuk (29:28) 'the hidden things are for Hashem, our G-d, and the revealed things are for us and our children...' in the name of the Rambam. He writes that all Mitzvos have reasons for them, but these reasons are beyond our full comprehension. We might try to ascribe certain reasons for individual Mitzvos, but they are ultimately beyond our comprehension - they are reflections of Divine wisdom. Our main job is to perform the Mitzvos and make sure to fulfil all their various Halochos, regardless of what the reason for the mitzvah is. 'The hidden ones are for Hashem' - let Him worry about the reasons for the Mitzvos, whilst 'the revealed ones are for us' - we should just worry about the Halochos of the Mitzvos; the things that we can be sure about.
