# Halacha from the Daf

The Chaye Adam (klal 67:1-2) writes that one who has a parent should exert great effort to attend to their needs. The reason, based on the language of Yerushalmi is that honouring parents is the weightiest of weighty mitzvos. A person is additionally obligated to honour and demonstrate awe for them since as our Gemorah (Sanhedrin Daf 50) relates the honour and awe for parents is equated with the honour and awe one is supposed to have for the creator. Furthermore, we are taught that there are three partners in a person, his mother, his father and Hashem. When a person honours his parents, Hashem considers it as though He lives in their midst and the child is honouring Him. When one causes pain and distress to parents Hashem responds by commenting that He is happy He does not dwell in their midst for if He lived in their midst He would have been distressed. The Chaye Adam proceeds to explain that the mitzvos that a child does to honour or demonstrate awe for a parent is the child's way of repaying his parents for all the kindnesses they performed on his behalf when he was younger. Consequently, a child who does not show honour or respect is called wicked since the pasuk refers to one who borrows money but does not repay that loan as wicked.

# Something for the Shabbos table

This week's parsha starts with "ViSamta Bateneh" - "You shall place the Bikkurim in a basket"; the mitzvah of Bikkurim.

Chazal tell us that the wealthy people would bring their Bikkurim in golden baskets which the Kohanim would return to them. As opposed to the poor who would bring it in wicker baskets which the Kohanim kept.

Why did the Kohanim return the baskets to the wealthy who did not need their baskets, and keep the poor man's basket?

The Meforshim explain, this was in order not to shame the poor. The wealthy gave expensive, beautiful fruit. Even without the golden basket it looked impressive. Therefore, the Kohanim returned the baskets to them. On the other hand, the poor gave low quality fruit. If it would have been removed from the basket, the poor man would be embarrassed. Therefore, the Kohanim kept their fruit and the baskets.
