<u>REGARDING TISHA B'AV ON A SUNDAY</u>

SHABBOS AFTERNOON

Mincha will be at the earlier time of **3:30pm** this is to give everyone ample time to go home and eat Seudah Shlishis. This meal may contain meat, wine and any cooked dishes that one has prepared before Shabbos.

Commencement of Fast 5:33pm – even though it is still Shabbos one must stop eating. However, one does not sit on the floor or remove ones shoes at this point (since we do not show public mourning on Shabbos)

Motzei Shabbos 6:17pm – Say *Boruch Hamavdil Bein Kodesh Lechol,* change ones shoes and proceed to Shul for Maariv

Maariv 6:45pm – No Havdalah over wine is made – The Brocha over Aish is made before Maariv (generally done at home)

Eichah 6:55pm followed by the Chofetz Chaim Heritage Foundation Video

SUNDAY - TISHA B'AV

Shacharis (without Tefillin) 8:30am followed by **explanatory Kinnos**Boys (grade 5+) will have their own Kinnos together with the overseas bochrim

12:26pm Chatzos, Halachic mid-day.

After this time, one may sit on regular chairs. Preparations for the meal-after-the-fast should wait till this time

2:00pm Second showing of CCHF Video for Women at the home of Family Berlin

Special Chofetz Chaim Video for KIDS

Girls - 12:45pm at the home of Family Berlin Boys - 3:45pm in the Shul (\$5 per person \$15 per family)

Mincha (with Tefillin) 5:00pm

Maariv 6:00pm Fast ends 6:10pm

Havdalah – one should make Havdalah before one eats. Only the brocha over the wine and Hamavdil are said. *One may drink the wine* – there is no need to give the wine to a child

All restrictions of the Nine Days apply till Mid-day on Monday - 12:26pm
